ACCORDING TO THE CANCERSUPPORTCOMMUNITY.ORG:

In a survey of 66 caregivers who are part of our Cancer Experience Registry® found:

- 98% provided emotional support
- 96% went with their loved one to medical appointments
- 82% helped with decision-making
- 79% coordinated medical care
- 80% provided transportation
- 74% helped manage finances
